

## The Alaska State Museums Professional Development Program

This program is designed to provide a mentored work experience for staff from small museums and tribal cultural centers throughout Alaska. It is modeled on the successful Exo program that helped move the ASM's collection into the new APK building and prepare artifacts for the new exhibits.

Participants will work side by side with museum professionals in a friendly collegial work environment and learn skills related to exhibits development and collections management. No previous knowledge or skills are necessary. All of the training will take place in the new APK building in Juneau. The training is for one week at a time but participants can choose to come for a second week during the grant cycle. Each week of training will be devoted to a single area but participants can choose another area for their second week.

The grant funding provides for air travel, hotel accommodations, and per diem at the state per diem rate for Juneau. Participants volunteer their time to participate in this program.
