SUMMER EXHIBITIONS TO CLOSE AT STATE MUSEUM

Ravens and photography by Alaska photographers are the subjects of two exhibitions at the Alaska State Museum that will have their final day for viewing this month. The exhibitions have been on display since last spring.

“RAUCOUS! Everything Raven,” a multi-faceted art and science exhibition, is the largest of the three shows and is the work of Ketchikan artist Evon Zerbetz. This show closes on Saturday, October 11.

“Alaska Positive 2008,” featuring 56 photographs by 42 Alaska photographers, is the museum’s biennial competition showcasing the best art photography currently being done in Alaska. This exhibition will close on Saturday, October 18.

Winter hours at the museum are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday. Admission is \$3. Visitors 18 and under are admitted free of charge. An annual pass that allows unlimited visits to the Alaska State Museum and the Sheldon Jackson Museum in Sitka is available for \$15. Assistance is available for visitors with special needs.
