**Alaska Positive 2012 Photography Exhibit
on Display for One More Week**

JUNEAU – January 5, 2013, will be the last day to view *Alaska Positive 2012* – the Alaska State Museum’s biennial juried photography exhibit at the museum in Juneau. The exhibit consists of 45 photographs reflecting Alaska’s breathtaking scenery, spectacular wildlife, and colorful people living and working against some of the most stunning backdrops on Earth.

“Every submission to Alaska Positive 2012 reflects pride in the state’s unique culture, industry and landscape,” said this year’s juror Holly Andres, an accomplished professional photographer from Portland, Oregon. “The judging process gave me a whole new appreciation for the contemporary Alaskan experience.”

Following its display at the Alaska State Museum, *Alaska Positive 2012* will be travelled around the state for the next two years.

The museum will be closed on New Year’s Day, Tuesday, January 1, 2013. Regular winter hours are 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday. Discounted winter admission is \$3. Visitors 18 and under are admitted free of charge. An annual pass that allows unlimited visits to the Alaska State Museum and the Sheldon Jackson Museum in Sitka is available for \$15.
