**Alaska State Museum open late for First Friday, FREE admission 4:30-7pm;
Closed Labor Day Holiday**

The Alaska State Museum will be open later than usual on September 2, for “First Friday.” The Museum will be open free of charge between 4:30 - 7:00. Volunteer docents will be stationed throughout the museum galleries to answer questions about objects, and pose a few object-based riddles to willing visitors.

In addition, the museum will be closed on Monday, September 5, for the Labor Day holiday.

Normal open hours are daily, seven days a week, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. General admission during normal hours is \$12 for adults, \$11 for seniors, and visitors 18 and younger, and Friends of the Alaska State Library, Archives, and Museum, and those with passes are admitted free.
