## **State Library, Archives, & Museum Alaska Day Holiday Closure**

The Alaska State Library, Archives, & Museum, located in the Fr. Andrew P. Kashevaroff building at 395 Whittier Street, will be closed on Tuesday, October 18<sup>th</sup>, in observance of Alaska Day. Winter hours will resume on Wednesday, October 19<sup>th</sup>, and are Tuesday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. The building is closed to the public on Sundays and Mondays during the winter season. Division employees are available by phone and e-mail Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. except on state holidays.

Discounted winter admission to the museum galleries is \$5, with those age 18 and under admitted free. An annual pass that allows unlimited visits to the Alaska State Museum and the Sheldon Jackson Museum in Sitka is available for \$25. Assistance is available for visitors who have special needs.
