LABOR DAY CLOSURE AT ALASKA STATE MUSEUM

The Alaska State Museum will be closed to the public on Labor Day, September 3, 2012.

Temporary exhibits on display include two World War II exhibitions: “When Over There Was Here and “Kiska: A World War II Battlefield Landscape,” and Juneau Painter Dan DeRoux’s exhibit in which uses humor to paint a slightly different picture of Alaskan history.

Summer hours at the museum are 8:30 to 5:30 daily. Summer admission is \$7 with a \$1 discount for age 65 and older. Visitors 18 and under are admitted free of charge. An annual pass that allows unlimited visits to the Alaska State Museum and the Sheldon Jackson Museum in Sitka is available for \$15. Assistance is available for visitors with special needs.
