Dentalia

Dentalia live in sandy soil on the ocean floor. There are many kinds of dentalia but the largest in North America are found off the west coast of Vancouver Island. These large shells were once used as a form of money.

Cut the top and bottom border along the dotted line to make the headdress.

One headdress in the Alaska State Museum made of white dentalium shells and glass beads was worn by a Tlingit woman named *Jiyal.áxch*. Dentalium shells are white tiny tusk-like shells found along the coast of North America from Southeast

A Bright Idea! You could make this headdress using chenille stems, pony beads, and macaroni

coast and inland through the Great Plains, Canada, and Alaska. Long ago dentalia was harvested from the ocean floor in 50 to 60 feet of water using long poles.
